Sharing the benefits of home dialysis

We want to change the view that In-centre HD is the status quo

We are not getting across the benefits and simplicity of home dialysis therapies currently.

Acute dialysis does not have to be HD – what about PD?

It is cheaper – but trusts don't see this financial benefit

Positive patient experiences can promote home therapies

To improve relationship and communication with contractors

We know home dialysis works - we need to encourage some more people to manage own lives and activities - and to see the benefits this can bring.

There is variation between trusts - we want to get rid of post-code care (e.g. different reimbursement policies, access to assisted therapies)

It improves patient outcomes

Knowing the end target helps - focus on the gains that can be made and goals

The risks can scare people - this can put people offbut we know people can overcome them and see huge benefits
