Develop systems and processes to enable appropriate patients within AKCC and those already on RRT to commence a supportive care pathway as a realistic treatment offer through shared decision making. (December 2021)

50% of patients identified by SQ to be offered an ACP and conversation started with those who require it by December 2021

Develop a skilled and competent MPT who can identify those who would benefit and begin appropriate conversations and sign posting (December 2021)

90% of all staff to have completed the first level communication module by September 2021

Patients

- Identifying suitable patients in AKCC and on RRT
- patient awareness
- PPI

- Scoping exercise - baseline measurement.
- Patient information booklet/posters
- Patient survey - co-design
- Patient group convened

Workforce

- Skilled and competent
- Identified and resourced
- Education

- Staff survey highlighting gaps in knowledge , skills & confidence. Development/implementation of education modules
- Collate current models and workforce to show gaps. Work with the MPT and include low clearance
- develop and implement a communication toolkit as part of tiered education modules

Pathways

- Agree and implement clinical pathway
- Agree data collection
- IT support

- Pilot implementation of ACP - initially in HD patients and then apply to pathway
- Collect baseline data and agree QI measures for collection
- Develop dashboard and screens for automated reporting quarterly

Report quarterly data on: How many supportive care patients with eGFR <15 and eGFR <10

Develop an implementation plan to collect symptom scores/burden and test it on a small cohort of patients
