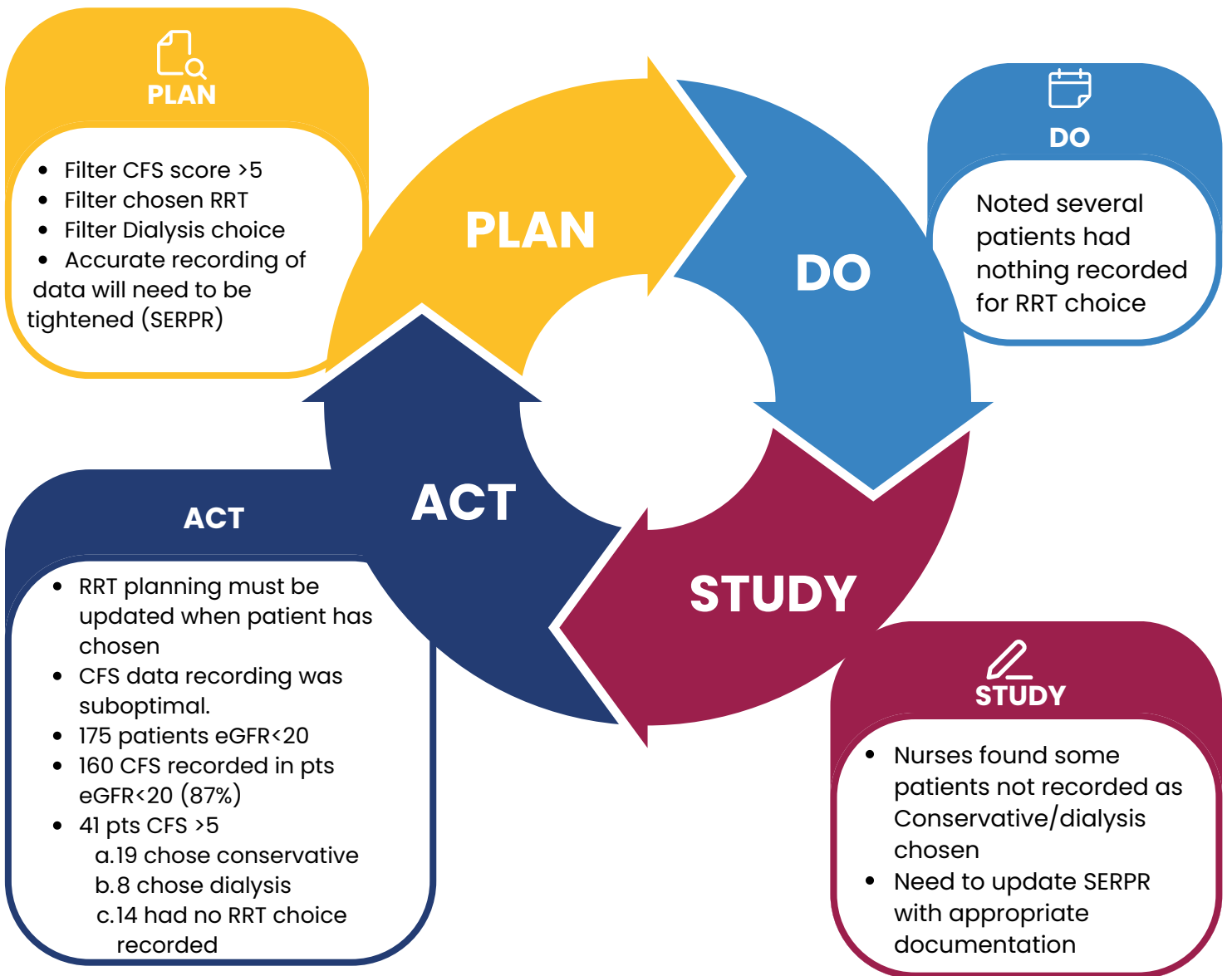

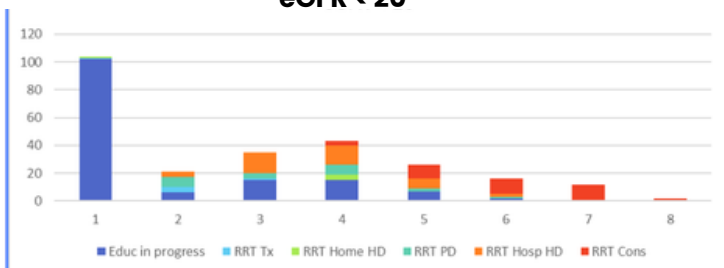
PDSA 2 – Audit CFS recording against RRT choice

Kilmarnock project aims:

eGFR < 20

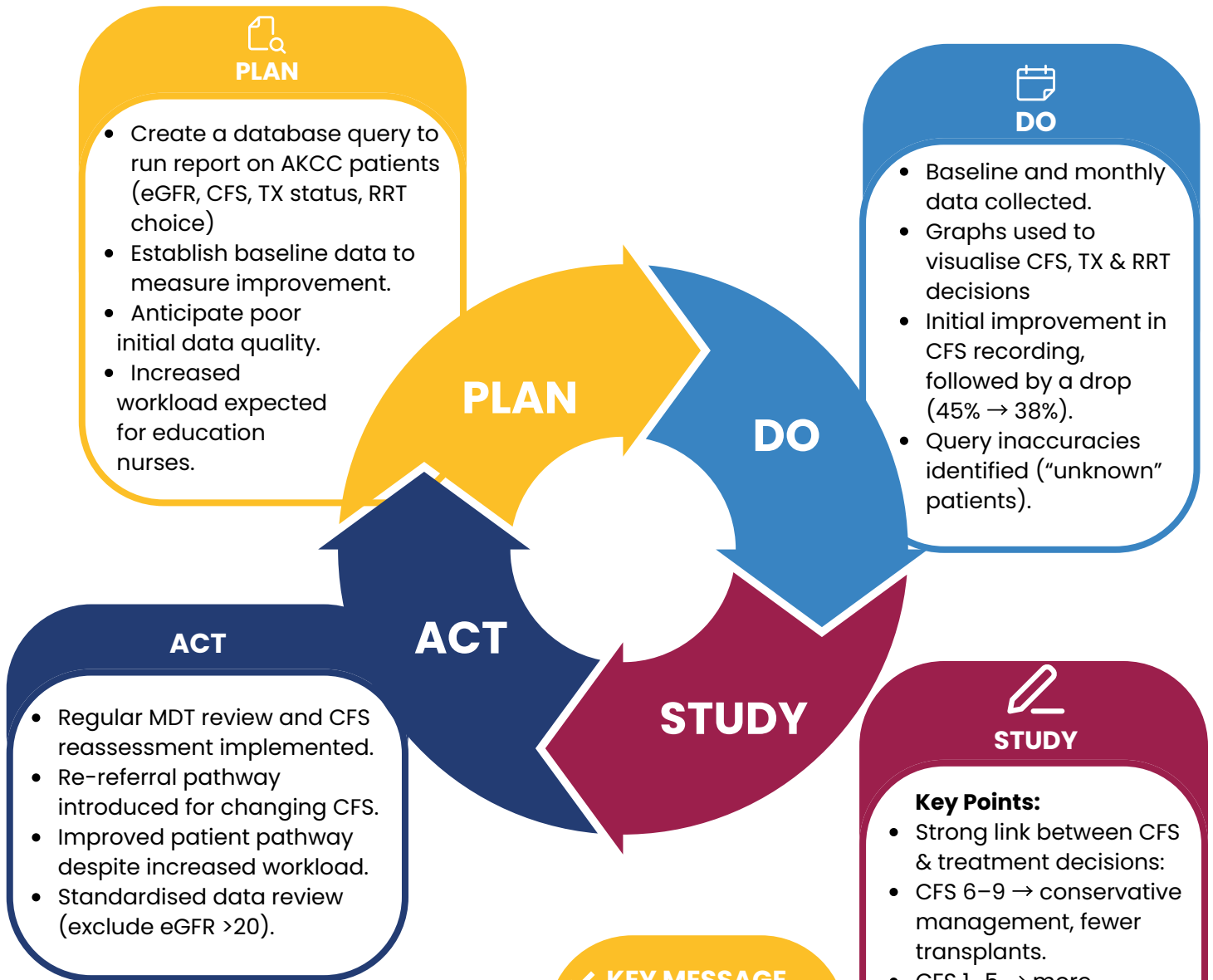


✓ KEY MESSAGE

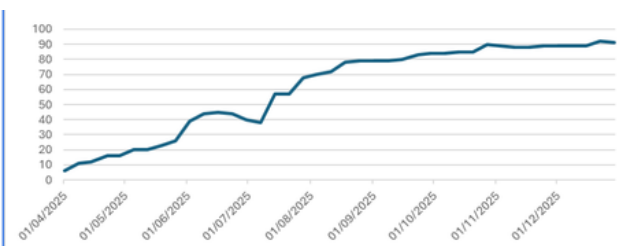

Implementing a structured EPR query & regular MDT review improves identification & management of AKCC patients > leading to more appropriate treatment decisions.
