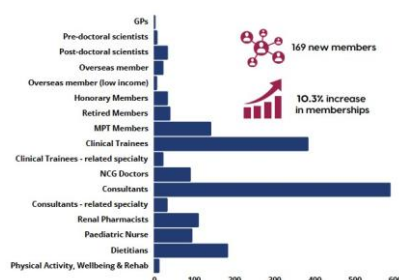

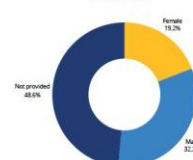

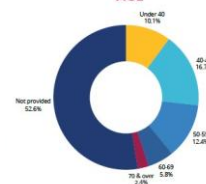
In 2023, membership of the UKKA grew and comprised over 1,810 doctors, scientists and MPT members.
